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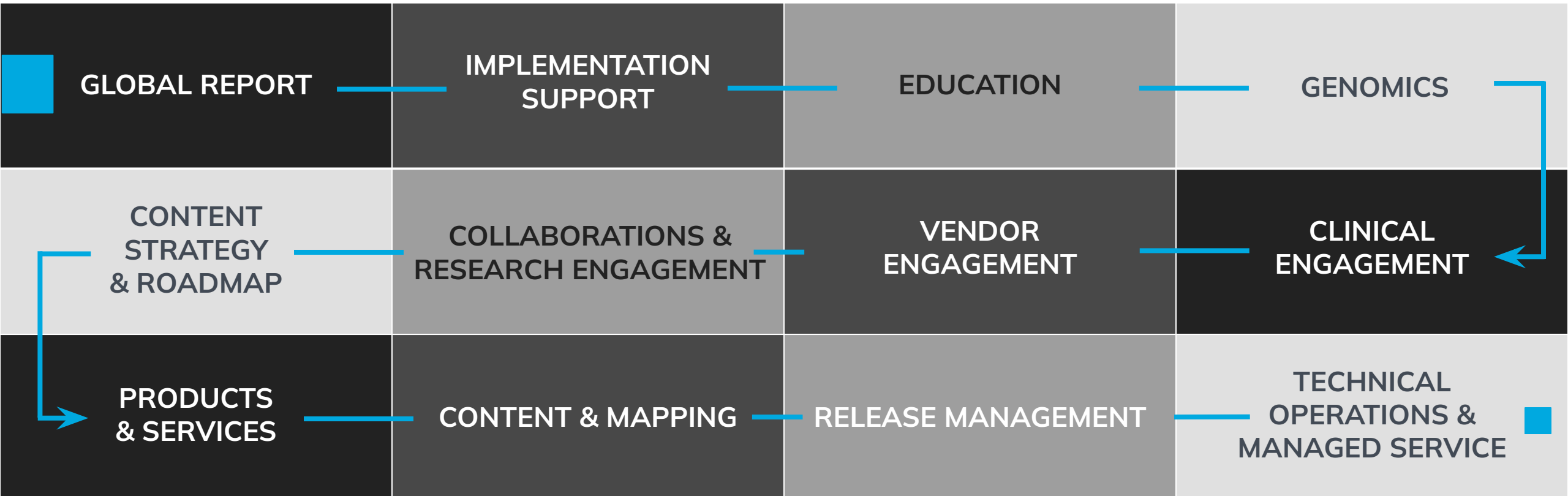

EUROPE – regional update

- **EU funding** - working with HADEA to maximise uptake of available funding for Members and non-Members
- SNOMED input into EU Projects - currently awaiting report publications
 - TEHDAS - European Health Dataspace
 - RECODID -Reconciliation of Cohort data in Infectious Diseases
- **MF EU group** - developing formal links with CEN (European Committee for Standardization)
- **SNOMED MIE 2020** presentation in May - “Practical use of SNOMED CT for analysing real world problems”
- **Future membership** - France, Croatia, Poland, working with Ministries to encourage membership



AMERICAS – regional update

- Assisted Argentina with content updates related to new country-wide legislation changes
- Participated on a panel at the JIS Go Live conference with other NRCs (Argentina, Uruguay and Spain)
- Presented to the GDHP Interoperability Work Stream on SNOMED CT and IPS
- Submitted input to US initiatives (NCVHS and USCDI) for continued SNOMED CT inclusion and support
- Continued Membership discussions and guidance on SNOMED CT and standards use with non-Members:
 - Brazil, Costa Rica, Columbia, Ecuador, El Salvador, Jamaica

- **Saudi Arabia** initiating their national eHealth transformation project through the Sehati gov't agency, with SNOMED at its core
- **Jordan** - investigating using SNOMED for procedures across the country
- Customer engagement at the Arab Health conference in **Dubai**, and at HIMSS in Orlando



 - Creation of a bidirectional map
- **Orphanet**
 - Content creation and map development
- **OMIM (Online Mendelian Inheritance of man)**

- **Identification of a Biobank pilot**
 - Documented practical guide to using SNOMED CT in a biobank environment
- **GA4GH (Global Alliance for Genomics and Health)**
 - Ensure SNOMED perspective is included in development of GA4GH roadmap, through interaction with clinical/phenotype workstream
- **ISO TC215 SC1 (Genomics Informatics)**

Planned activities for 2022

- **OMIM (Online Mendelian Inheritance of man)**
 - Development of an extension to SNOMED CT concept model to allow the recording of gene variants
 - Development of a pilot of authored content to be made available in community content area
 - Use case is to support the use of genetically defined diseases within the EHR, to support for example clinical geneticists
- **Identification of a Biobank pilot**
 - Identification of a biobank site currently using SNOMED CT to record patient data
 - Produce a practical guide to using SNOMED CT in a biobank environment
 - Leverage and document regional developments to link biobanks, using both SNOMED CT and FHIR to identify optimal approach
 - Document patient data collection flows into biobank environment leveraging REDCAP forms

RESEARCH ENGAGEMENT *update*

- Updated the Research Engagement strategy
 - Refined in 2020 and again in 2021 due to ongoing global pandemic
- SNOMED CT Research Webinars
 - Established in 2020 (848 registered/475 attended) and continued to gain in popularity through 2021 (906 registered/540 attended)
- Research Reference Group grew in 2021 (91 individuals)
- Engagement (including research license waivers and SNOMED CT technical specification discussions) continued with individual researchers and organizations in Member and non-Member territories
 - Examples: Federal Institute of Cear (IFCE), National Center for Advancing Translational Sciences (NCATS), Safe Surgery South Africa, Suramericana,
- Determined research organizations for partnership and executing within Collaboration Framework
- 2022 Goals:
 - Launch a Confluence space for researchers
 - New Expo stream focused on SNOMED CT research
 - Even more global representation of presenters at the Research Webinars

External editor policy details

Content collaboration

Collaborative agreement with American Joint Committee on Cancer (AJCC)

SNOMED International has entered into an agreement with AJCC to add a comprehensive list of cancer “allowable values” to SNOMED CT.

Existing obsolete AJCC related findings will be inactivated and replaced by a current list of qualifier values.

Definitions for these values for each tissue type must be obtained from AJCC.

Social care

Survey of Members related to Social Care

- The meaning and scope of “Social care” differs from country to country
- Social care services are divided between health care and social services systems.
- Increased interest in collecting social care data by members
 - Most are just beginning

Social care priorities

- services for older people including home care/support, long term care and palliative care
- services for people with mental health problems
- services for people with alcohol and substance misuse problems
- SNOMED International, in conjunction with the HL7 Gravity Project, is updating and enhancing Social Determinants of Health content
- Additional gaps in Social care priority areas being identified

LOINC Expression Set

Post coordinated expressions representing LOINC terms

- First published in 2017
- Represented over 20,000 LOINC terms as SNOMED expressions
- Project to update and expand the set based on latest versions of LOINC and SNOMED

LOINC expression set details

- Updated to reflect LOINC version 2.71 (Aug 2021)
- Attributes and attribute values updated to current SNOMED CT International release
- Current active expressions - 21,777
 - Sufficiently defined - 19,473
 - Primitive - 2,304
- New terms added since 2017 - 549
- Expressions inactivated - 689





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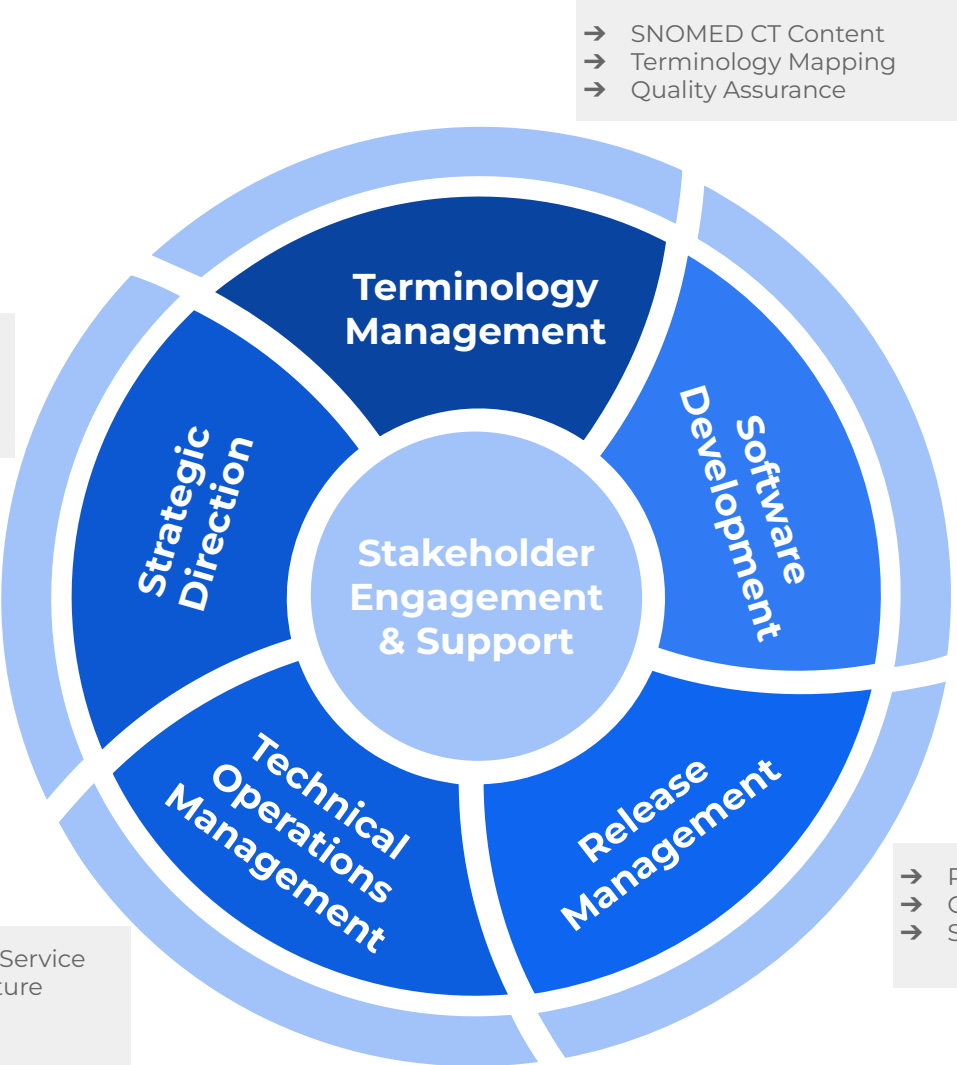

1. SNOMED International have now refined their Map Reference Set product formats (see RM Blog for details)
2. The upcoming 2022 MedDRA release will be the first to implement the new formats.

IPS Terminology

1. SNOMED International will be releasing a BETA package of the sub-ontology in 2022.
2. This will be a non-SNOMED CT product, but rather a distinct Snapshot package published on the website.
