Agreement for the following disorders to be **retired** (as they are misnomers and superseded by terms in the list of preferred glaucoma preferred diagnoses):

- 30041005 | Acute angle-closure glaucoma (disorder) |
- 347381000119106 | Bilateral acute angle-closure glaucoma (disorder) |
- 336611000119109 | Acute angle-closure glaucoma of right eye (disorder) |
- 342221000119104 | Acute angle-closure glaucoma of left eye (disorder) |
- Following the meeting, I also suggest the following term is **modified**:
From 157533041000119108 | History of acute angle-closure glaucoma (situation) |
To: | History of acute angle-closure (situation) |
- 193562004 | Glaucoma due to ocular vascular disorder (disorder)
- 95213001 | Primary glaucoma due to combination of mechanisms (disorder)

Agreement for the following terms to be **added**:

- |Ocular hypertension due to retinal detachment (disorder)|
Note there is an existing term: 788948008 | Glaucoma due to retinal detachment (disorder) |
- |Ocular hypertension due to ocular surgery (disorder)|
Note the existing term: 232090003 | Glaucoma following surgery (disorder) |
has been recommended by the CRG to be **modified** to |Glaucoma following ocular surgery (disorder)|
- |Medication-induced open angle glaucoma|
- |Medication-induced ocular hypertension|
- |Medication-induced angle closure glaucoma|
- |Medication-induced angle closure|
- |Medication-induced acute angle closure|
Note the existing term: 93435005 | Drug-induced glaucoma (disorder) |
could be retired as the above terms would replace this

Further work to be done:

- Post-co-ordination terms on severity of glaucoma (including indeterminate severity) based on internationally agreed definitions
- Adding secondary ocular hypertension terms to match preferred secondary open angle glaucoma terms
- ? adding new terms for secondary angle closure (with no glaucoma) and secondary acute angle closure (with no glaucoma) to match existing secondary angle closure glaucoma terms
- Update and discuss proposed glaucoma diagnoses SNOMED terms at next meeting
