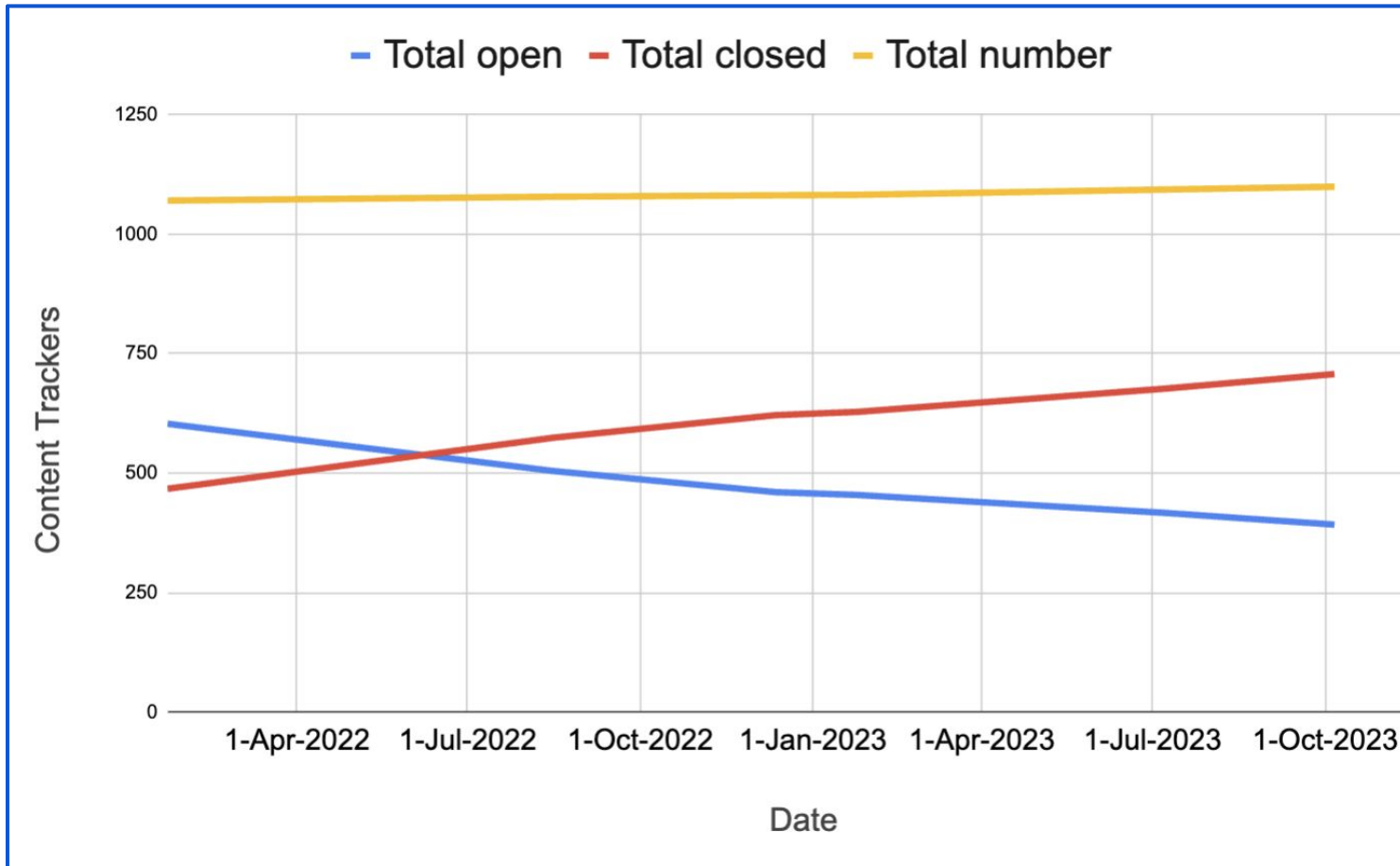
# Administration

# CMAG Contributions

- In 2023 CMAG input was provided on:
  - Inactivation of Navigational concept hierarchy
  - Inactivation of ethnic and racial group social context content
  - Inactivation of Payment for service status (finding) sub-hierarchy
  - Change from 'International Unit' terming to 'IU' in clinical drug content
  - Inactivation of Clinical finding and Procedure concepts which include the context of subject or patient in the FSN
  - Planning for the ICD-O-3.2 map

# IHTSDO Content Tracker Activity



Previously - high level reviews by one team member as time permitted

June 2023 - team reviewing commenced

- Status of issue
  - Work outstanding?
  - Overlap other work?
  - Effort required?
- Progressing smaller trackers within resourcing limits



# Concept Promotion - Another Extension

- Process steps
  - Check concept is published
  - Extension A contacts extension B requesting promotion
    - Required request submission information must be provided by Extension A to Extension B - see template in guide
  - Extension B requests promotion
- Promotion requests
  - Managed service customer - via authoring platform
  - Other - via CRS

# Content Issue Management

- Management of a reported content issue
  - Smaller issues - managed as they arise
  - Medium to large issues
    - Considerations
      - Impact of issue e.g. clinical impact
      - Size and complexity e.g. current model or new model
      - Access to clinical expertise
      - Ease to fix e.g. can it be automated
      - Alignment with work plan
      - Resource availability- Terminologist, Clinical SMEs
      - Implementation requirements
    - May require a content tracker

# Content Issue Management -Internal

- Customer request system requests
  - Shared - topic may impact who manages
  - Additional input sought where required
- Internally identified content issues
  - Simple and small - corrected as part of BAU
  - Larger - tracker or escalated
- Discussion required (includes CRS)
  - Internal JIRA project with weekly internal meeting
  - Issues may be escalated
    - Editorial Panel (Internal group) - monthly as needed
    - EAG - if editorial guidance required
    - Briefing note or discussion topic



# Briefing Notes vs. Discussion Topics

- Content briefing notes
  - Types
    - Informational - additional to early visibility
    - Requesting input/feedback
  - Use
    - Larger issues
    - Change is more extensive or has more impact
    - Broader community input is required
    - Proactive notification
      - Still need to watch early visibility page and project reports
    - Sent to MF, CMAG, Clinical Leads and EAG
- Discussion Topics
  - Targeted input - e.g. when working with a CRG
  - Smaller issues

# *Timelines and Outcomes for Topics*

- Timelines
  - In general - are timelines sufficient?
  - July - August period - is more time required?
- Updates on issue resolution
  - Early visibility page is updated
  - Can look at posting outcome on topic pages
