For users that did not use the March 2020 Interim International Edition in their systems, the linked documentation provides a summarized description of the content changes included in the July 2020 additional Rollup Delta package release and is intended for National Release Centers, WHO-FIC release centers, vendors of electronic health records, terminology developers and managers who wish to have an understanding of changes that have been incorporated into the July 2020 International Edition additional Rollup Delta package.

Users should note that as this Rollup Delta package incorporates all Delta file changes from both March 2020 and July 2020 releases, they should refer to both sets of original Release Notes for details of all content & technical changes included.
